Our Addiction Management Services Program continues to expand, especially one-on-one peer recovery coaching. To keep up with demand and ensure high quality, we spent considerable time revamping our recovery coach training program and developing additional resources to ensure our coaches have the right skills to meet the diverse needs of our clients.

We also created an ongoing training program to help current coaches learn new skills and collaborate. Next in the works is a curriculum specific to coaching family members of individuals suffering from addiction.

Solving Addiction on the Green, our golf event, doubled in size in 2015! We were thrilled to partner with The First Tee of South Dakota, which meant having a youth from their program golf with every team. It's proved to be a fun, innovative take on the traditional non-profit golf event.

This was our third year with Funded Agency status with the Sioux Empire United Way, which has helped us become a leader in outcomes measurement and evaluation. We're grateful for the continuing support of the community and all of our many partners. We look forward to a strong 2016 ahead.
